Compatibility

All-City Fuzzy Bars require a stem with a 22.2mm clamp diameter.

Save The Track Bike Bars require a stem with a 31.8mm clamp diameter.

Intended Use

All-City Fuzzy Bars are intended and designed for casual trail or city/commuting/trekking. Not intended for downhill mountain bike use.

Save The Track Bike Bars drop handlebars are intended for road and track bicycles and city/commuting/trekking.

⚠ WARNING: All-City handlebars are not intended to be used with clip-on aero bars or barend extensions.

Tools

Allen wrenches: 4, 5, 6mm; torque wrench that measures in Newton meters.

Handlebar Installation

1. Remove the bolts from the stem faceplate.
2. Center the handlebar on the stem.
3. Lubricate the handlebar clamp bolts with grease. Lightly clamp the handlebar face plate onto center of the handlebar, inserting and tightening all bolts just enough to hold the bar. Center and rotate the handlebar to the desired position. On a four-bolt face plate for example, alternately tighten the bolts to the stem manufacturer's torque specifications, working from the upper left, to the lower right, to the upper right, to the lower left in half turn increments until they reach an equal reading, or between 5–8Nm if manufacturer's specifications are not available. The upper and lower gaps, between the front cap and the rear portion of the handlebar clamp, should be equal.
4. Install shift and brake levers and tighten according to manufacturer's specifications. Install handlebar tape or grips as needed.
5. While straddling the toptube and holding the front wheel between your legs, make a strong attempt to rotate the handlebars up or down. If the bar rotates, increase the face plate bolt torque; do not exceed 8Nm. If maximum torque has been reached and the bar still rotates, please take your bicycle to your local bicycle dealer for inspection of the handlebar/stem interface.

⚠ WARNING: Improperly installed steering components may lead to component failure, resulting in serious injury or death.

6. Check the tightness of the stem bolts according to the manufacturer's specifications before each ride. Do not overtighten.

Limited Warranty

This All-City® product is warranted against defects in materials and workmanship for three years from the date of retail purchase of the product, subject to the limitations detailed below. Save your dated receipt for proof of purchase.

This warranty does NOT cover the following:

- Damage due to improper assembly or follow-up maintenance or lack of skill, competence or experience of the user or assembler
