Compatibility

All-City Saddles are compatible with seatposts that accept 7mm saddle rail diameter.

Required Tools

4, 5, and 6mm Allen wrenches Torque wrench that measures in Newton meters

Single-Bolt Seatposts:

Install your seat on a single-bolt seatpost by loosening the "sandwich" bolt at the top of the post most of the way. The diameter of the saddle rails must match the diameter of the grooves in the clamp. Then turn the top half of the clamp 90° (figure 1) and fit the saddle onto the rails (figure 2). Turn the top clamp back into position and tighten the bolt just enough to hold the saddle in place in a level to the ground position for starters (figure 3).

Tighten the seatpost bolt clamp on the frame to secure the seat in place before you decide what adjustments will need to be made.

NOTE: After making the necessary saddle adjustments, tighten the saddle rail clamp bolt(s) to the seatpost manufacturer's recommended torque.

Two-Bolt Seatposts:

Installation of the saddle in this seatpost may require you to completely undo one clamp (figure 4). Fit the saddle onto the grooves and reinsert the bolt that you had to undo (figure 5). The diameter of the saddle rails must match the diameter of the grooves in the clamp. Lightly tighten both bolts until they hold the saddle in place.

Tighten the seatpost bolt clamp on the frame to secure the seat in place before you decide what adjustments will need to be made.

NOTE: After making the necessary saddle adjustments, tighten the saddle rail clamp bolt(s) to the seatpost manufacturer's recommended torque.


