Named for our good friend and 17-year Minneapolis Messenger veteran, Tim Gellerman (3.14 or Pi was his messenger nickname). The 314 Messenger ring is manufactured from the same high-grade 7000-series alloy as the 612 Track Ring but features the popular 130 BCD. Maybe you already own a "messenger" crankset and need a ring that won't cost you an arm and a leg, or maybe you've got a road crankset that you're converting to single or fixed use. Either way the 314 is perfect for the application.

Intended Use

INTENDED For track or paved roads that are in good condition, and bike paths.

NOT INTENDED For off-road or mountain bike use, or for any kind of jumping. They ARE NOT intended for multi-speed drivetrains.

Tools

Chainring nut wrench

5mm Allen wrench

Installation

- 1. Remove crankset or right crank arm from bottom bracket.
- 2. Remove chainings you wish to replace.
- 3. Clean crankarm and chainring bolts thoroughly.
- 4. Grease chaining bolts and install the All-City 314 chaining. The machined recess around the chaining bolt hole allows the chaining bolt to sit flush with the surface of the ring. Make sure the bolts fit down into these recesses.
- 5. Install the chaining nuts from the back of the crank spider.
- 6. Install the chainring bolts through the front of the All-City 314 chainring and alternately tighten them evenly to chainring bolt manufacturer's recommended torque specifications.

▲ WARNING: Periodically check to make sure the chainring bolts are tightened to the proper torque specifications. Failure to do so and riding with a loose chainring could cause a crash resulting in serious injury or even death.

NOTE: Remember to keep your chain and chainrings well lubricated, and remember to inspect these and all other components for excessive wear, accidental damage, and premature failure before every ride.
