Compatibility

All-City pedals are for 9/16" pedal threads. All of our pedals will accommodate toe clips and straps.

Intended Use

All-City pedals are designed for road and track riding. They are not intended for off-road use or stunt riding.





Left Pedal (Left-hand thread)

Required Tools

6mm Allen wrench

Pedal wrench

Grease for threads

NOTE: Never use a cone wrench to remove or install a pedal.

Installing Pedals

1. Begin by identifying the right and left pedals. Look for "L" and "R" marking on axle or wrench flats.

NOTE: Pedal spindle threads are different from left side and right side. The right side pedal has a right-hand thread (threads in clockwise) and is intended for use on the driveside of a bike (to the right when sitting on the bike). The left side pedal has a left-hand thread (threads in counterclockwise) for use on the non-driveside (to the left while seated).

▲ CAUTION: Do not attempt to install a right-side pedal into the left-side crank or vce versa. Doing so could permanently damage your crank AND pedal. Left-threaded pedals (threads sloping upward to the left) go on the left crank. Right-threaded pedals (threads sloping upward to the right) go on the right crank. See image above if in doubt.

- 2. Heavily grease threads of both pedals.
- 3. Thread the right-side pedal into right crank by hand, CLOCKWISE.
- 4. To tighten fully, use the pedal wrench or 6mm Allen wrench. Torque to 18Nm.
- 5. Repeat these steps for the left-side pedal, making sure to tighten by turning COUNTER-CLOCKWISE.

NOTE: Periodically check both pedals for tightness and retighten according to these instructions if necessary.

▲ WARNING: Immediately discontinue using the pedals if excessive play develops, the pedal body or spindle shows signs of cracking, or the pedal body seems too tight or too loose on the spindle. Take your bicycle or pedals to a professional bicycle mechanic for evaluation and service.
